## **How to make more than 40 security() calls? - Stack Overflow**

The workaround is not to have more security() calls, but to be able to fetch many more values than 40, with those 40 security() calls, by using tuples. As demonstrated in my answer, 7 values are fetched with one security() call. So by using the maximum 40 security() calls, you could fetch  $7 \times 40 = 280$  values.
