Among all extant bony fishes, the beluga sturgeon rivals the ocean sunfish (*Mola* sp.) as the most massive fish and is the second-longest bony fish after the giant oarfish (*Regalecus glesne*). It is the largest freshwater fish in the world.

To date, the largest sturgeon was a female beluga (*Huso huso*) that was 23 feet and 7 inches long, weighing 3,436 pounds. The fish was caught in the Volga River estuary in Russia on May 28, 1827. Beluga sturgeon are prized for their caviar, which is considered a pinnacle of luxury.

Beluga is the largest freshwater fish in the world. This massive fish can reach over 15 feet long and weigh upwards of 2,500 pounds. The largest recorded beluga sturgeon was almost 20 feet long and over 7,000 pounds. These fish also have a long lifespan, living to 100 years and older.
