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Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale 10-Item | RehabMeasures Database

The CD-RISC 10 is a unidimensional self-reported scale consisting of 10-items measuring resilience. Respondents rate items on a 5-point Likert scale, ranging from 0 (not true at all) to 4 (true nearly all the time). Each item has a minimum score of 0 and a maximum score of 4.

How to Use the Connor Davidson Resilience Scale (CD-RISC)

What is the Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale? (CD-RISC) The Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale is a test that measures resilience or how well one is equipped to bounce back after stressful events, tragedy, or trauma. Resilience gives us the ability to thrive in the face of adversity.

This report presented psychometric data establishing validity and reliability of the scale (known as the Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale or CD-RISC), as well as briefly describing each of the 25 items (see Table 2 of that citation), and giving general scoring directions.

This scale has been widely used and validated in dozens of studies. The user guide also provides benchmark data so scores can be compared to the general population and specific subpopulations (e.g., PTSD samples).

This study assessed the psychometric properties of the 10-item Connor Davidson Resilience Scale (CD-RISC-10), a self-report measure of resilience, in youth receiving treatment and/or screening positive for depression/suicidality in psychiatric outpatient settings.

target of treatment in anxiety, depression, and stress reactions. We describe a new rating scale to assess resilience.

The Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale (CD-RISC) was developed by Kathryn M. Connor and Jonathan R.T. Davidson as a means of assessing resilience. [1] The CD-RISC is based on Connor and Davidson's operational definition of resilience, which is the ability to "thrive in the face of adversity."

The refined Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale (CD-RISC; Campbell-Sills & Stein, 2007) is a shortened version of the original 25-item, 5-factor measure developed by Connor & Davidson (2003) to assess personal resources or qualities deemed appropriate for positive adaptations to adversity.
