And if your physician performed a total laparoscopic hysterectomy, look to codes 58570-58573 or 58575 (Laparoscopy, surgical, total hysterectomy for resection of malignancy [tumor debulking], with omentectomy including salpingo-oophorectomy, unilateral or bilateral, when performed).

Coding Clinic indicates that, for the vNOTES procedure, you would select from CPT® code range 58260-58294 as it captures "the vaginal hysterectomy based on what was performed during the operation and the weight of the uterus." Although a laparoscopic device is utilized, the hysterectomy

is still performed vaginally.

With so many code choices, be sure all related procedures are accounted for. Although hysterectomy is a common procedure in gynecology practice, coding for it is a challenge due to so many code choices. If your ob-gyn performed a hysterectomy using a vaginal approach, you'll pull a code from the 58260-58294 series. Laparoscopic procedure: For a laparoscopic-assisted vaginal hysterectomy (LAVH), you'll use 58550-58554. If your ob-gyn performed a supracervical laparoscopic hysterectomy, you'll report one of four new-for-2007 codes: 58541-58544.

For non-Medicare carriers the suspension procedure is billed in addition to the code for the hysterectomy (e.g. 58150 Total abdominal hysterectomy [corpus and cervix] with or without removal of tube [s] with or without removal of ovary [s]).
