Dissociative Experiences Scale - II (DES-II)

The client's score indicates severe dissociative experiences consistent with levels typically seen in dissociative disorders. They are likely experiencing substantial disruptions in consciousness, memory, identity, and perception that cause significant impairment in daily functioning.
