Both of them emphasize text. The `<em>` tag shows text as italics, whereas `<strong>` makes it bold. Is this the only difference?

What's the difference between **em** and **strong** tags?

While `em` and `strong` are of course more semantically correct, there seem definite legitimate reasons to use the `em` and `strong` tags for customer-written content.

em has the purpose of giving emphasis to the content. In practice emphasised content is typically displayed italicised, so the difference on the face of it is non-existing from a presentation standpoint. However, emphasis is semantic while italics is presentation. i was deprecated in favour of em to make HTML a truly semantic markup.
