Subsequently, question is, what are the different types of monarchy? To be classified as a monarchy, a government must have some kind of royal family that inherits their position of power. Different types of monarchs exist. A monarchy may be a limited monarchy, a constitutional monarchy, or an absolute monarchy.

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The difference between absolute monarchy and constitutional monarchy is that in the absolute monarchy, the monarch holds the supreme or absolute powers, whereas in the constitutional monarchy, the head of state is a hereditary or elected monarch.

What does Thomas Hobbes say about government? Throughout his life, Hobbes believed that the only true and correct form of government was the absolute monarchy. He argued this most forcefully in his landmark work, *Leviathan*. This belief stemmed from the central tenet of Hobbes' natural philosophy that human beings are, at their core, selfish creatures.

Besides, does Ergotism still exist? Two epidemics of gangrenous ergotism were reported (1978 and 2001) in Ethiopia due to *Claviceps purpurea sclerotia* from wild oats contaminating barley (0.75% ergot). Although epidemics of ergotism do not occur in developed countries, contamination of grain by *Claviceps* spp. is still common.

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
