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genesis - How long did Jacob stay in Harran? - Biblical Hermeneutics ...

Problem: At 91, Jacob still works for Laban, having Joseph and requesting to leave Laban, (30:25) and still continuing to work more. That's 28 years minimum, not 20.

How long did Jacob live with laban? - Answers

Whose wages did laban change and how many times? Laban changed Jacob's wages multiple times while working for him - specifically, he changed Jacob's wages 10 times as mentioned in Genesis 31:7.

In Genesis 29:18, what is the significance that Jacob offered to work ...

Dottard Correct Laban was greedy, he bartered for both of his daughters., Although he played the part of the benevolent uncle, he reduced his blood relationship with Jacob to a service contract. Since Jacob was in love with Rachel, he replied: "I am will serve you seven years for your younger daughter Rachel." What would seven years in wages amount to?

How many years did Jacob work for rachel? - Answers

Short answer: Jacob worked 7 years for Laban before he married his two wives, Leah and Rachel. Long answer: Jacob worked 7 years to pay Rachel's bride price, but his father-in-law Laban tricked him ...

Did Laban change his mind about giving Rachel to Jacob before he had ...

Genesis 29:30 NASB So Jacob had relations with Rachel also, and indeed he loved Rachel more than Leah, and he served with [g]Laban for another seven years. Did Laban change his mind about waiting another seven years before giving Rachel to Jacob?

genesis - How old was Jacob when he first saw Rachel? - Biblical ...

I would hazard an extra year could/should be added so that Joseph was 40 when Jacob was 130, ie Joseph born when Jacob was 90. 2ndly, I think Joseph was a toddler when they left Harran, either 2 or 3, maybe even 4 years old, meaning Jacob was either 92, 93, maybe even 94 years old. Meaning he first saw Rachel when he was 72, 73, maybe even 74.

genesis - Did Laban change Jacob's wages 10 times - Biblical

Laban may have changed (and from the instances noted, it is likely he did) the wages more times than are mentioned in scripture. But Jacob was aware of it, from experience. Such situations result in an opinion-based response. (As with the authors mentioned in the question.)

genesis - Why did God wait to give the law later? - Biblical ...

the problem with that line of reasoning is that Laban was not a party to the covenant between God and the people of Israel (Jacob). And in any case his character was such that he did not honor the law, whether of God or of conscience.

Did Jacob acquire all his wealth in Paddan Aram in the last 6 years of ...

Jacob married Leah and Rachel after 7 years of working for Laban. He decided to go back to Canaan after Joseph had been born. That would mean that all his children were born in 7 years period, which is impossible. Jacob had seven kids with Leah (Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Dinah). She stopped having children between Judah and Issachar. This is when she gave Jacob her ...

How many years did Jacob work for a wife? - Answers

Jacob worked a total of 14 years for his wives, Leah and Rachel. He initially worked seven years to marry Rachel, but was deceived into marrying Leah first.
