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What is the difference between "me encanta" and "yo encanto " ? "me ...

Synonym for me encanta 'me encanta' means 'I love it'. While 'yo encanto' means 'I am lovely' or 'I am enchanting'. In 'yo encanto', you become the object that's being described by the verb.

What is the difference between "encanto" and "amo ... - HiNative

Synonym for encanto "Encanto" works a little differently. Te encanto- You love me. (lit: "I enchant you") Te amo- I love you. | Amo (Amar) tiene un significado más romántico y normalmente no se utiliza.
