With /Mount-Image you can only mount image from a WIM or VHD file. Its good idea to convert .ESD image file to .Wim image file. A file with the ESD file extension is a file downloaded using Microsoft's Electronic Software Download application, so the file itself is called a Windows Electronic Software Download file.
