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Pepcid For Greyhounds? - Food and dietary discussion - Greytalk

Pepcid is pretty benign but, like any med, shouldn't be used unless needed. Usually it's used for inappetence / upset stomach / vomiting. Occasionally a vet will suggest it for mild diarrhea -- if the stomach is too acidic, diarrhea can result, and Pepcid can take the edge off of that.

Pepcid 30 to 45 minutes before mealtime, then his other pills on top of the food. You can get the generic famotidine. It comes in 10mg pills. Sam gets three 10mg pills every morning (on vet's orders); he gets them in the evening only if he's having stomach trouble. I tuck Sam's pills into a half-slice of cheese; the pills shouldn't be chewed, and if I give them naked to Sam, he'll try to ...

I discussed it with the vet yesterday and I do plan to try 10 mg of pepcid twice a day to see if that will help. Other than a swollen toe, he is normal. High energy, walking ok, etc. Thoughts? thanks!

Full disclosure: the Pepcid is our own doing -- the vet didn't mention it -- but I'm paranoid about ulcers/bleeding. Starting tonight I might give less kibble at dinnertime and give her the rest instead of bread before dose #2. She's finally lost a few pounds and I don't want to undo that! Pepcid (Famotidine) For Diarrhea? - Health and Medical ... - Greytalk

No, Pepcid AC is not the same as Flagyl and will not treat diarrhea. It is an anti-acid, to help reduce stomach acid. IMMODIUM does treat diarrhea, and can be given to dogs if needed. You can give one tablet every eight hours (*per my former vet/employer). Sometimes, diarrhea is caused by a bacteria or virus, though, and supressing it isn't always the best thing. Flagyl treats bacterial type ...
