Smith's Bible Dictionary Rephidim (Exodus 17:1,8; 19:2) The name means rests or stays , i.e. resting places. The place lies in the march of the Isr'lites from Egypt to Sinai. Its site is not certain, but it is perhaps Wady Feiran , a rather broad valley about 25 miles from Jebel Musa (Mount Sinai).
