11 In SQL, anything you evaluate / compute with NULL results into UNKNOWN. This is why `SELECT * FROM MyTable WHERE MyColumn != NULL` or `SELECT * FROM MyTable WHERE MyColumn NULL` gives you 0 results. To provide a check for NULL values, `isNull` function is provided. Moreover, you can use the `IS` operator as you used in the third query.

## What does the "@" symbol do in SQL? - Stack Overflow

The @CustID means it's a parameter that you will supply a value for later in your code. This is the best way of protecting against SQL injection. Create your query using parameters, rather than

concatenating strings and variables. The database engine puts the parameter value into where the placeholder is, and there is zero chance for SQL injection.
