## **Saxophones - What is the difference between the different types of ...**

The main difference is pitch, hence size. Saxes are transposing instruments, so the fingering is the same for all saxes, assuming you're playing from a part for your instrument. In playing, the difference is firstly the pitch - most saxes are in either Eb (Bari/alto/sopranino) or Bb (Bass/tenor/soprano), although some can be found in C (C melody or C tenor, soprano) or F (really rare).
