Tuesdays or Tuesday's? You can use "Tuesdays" when referring to multiple instances of "Tuesday." It's the plural form (i.e. "I like Tuesdays"). You can use "Tuesday's" as the singular possessive form, showing that "Tuesday" owns an object. For example, "Tuesday's news" demonstrates this.
