The Omaha Platform: A Populist Plan That Still Echoes Today

One of the central planks of the Omaha Platform was the call for "free and unlimited coinage of silver" at a ratio of 16 to 1 with gold. Rationale: Populists believed that increasing the money supply by coining silver would lead to inflation, raising crop prices and easing the burden of debt.
