About Woodrow Wilson

Wilson was awarded the 1919 Nobel Peace Prize and heralded in Europe as a savior of peace. Exhausted from his vigorous efforts toward ratification of the Versailles Treaty, which included traveling 8,000 miles by rail around the country; Wilson suffered a severe stroke and would never fully recover.
