## Honest opinions of current Weber Speakers - The Gear Page

I've tried many Weber speakers and I still don't know why they refer to some models as "vintage". Maybe some of them sound like vintage Celestion speakers, but none of them sound like vintage

Jensen speakers. I'm not saying that Weber speakers sound bad, they just don't sound like vintage Jensen speakers.

## **Holy Crap.. The Weber Signature Alnico Speaker has a 7 oz magnet ...**

Ok, but if we look at the 12" Weber Alnico 12A150 it uses a 40 oz magnet and puts out 25 watts. The Singature 12" Alnico is also 25 watts but only uses a 7 oz magnet. In looking at Weber other offerings, however, I see that some of the Vintage line (not the sign line) also uses 7 oz magnets on the Alnicos.

### **Weber 10a125 - Telecaster Guitar Forum**

The Weber 10A125 would be comparable to a Jensen P10Q and has an 11 oz. alnico magnet and a 1.25" voice coil. The 10A125 would be my choice to keep the amp sounding close to original. FYI, I have two recomed 1961 P10Q's in my 1960 Super that were done at Weber with the 10A125 cone and 30 watt voice coil.
