Can I apply the required attribute to fields in HTML?

The required attribute is a boolean attribute. When specified, the user will be required to select a value before submitting the form. If a select element has a required attribute specified, does not have a multiple attribute specified, and has a display size of 1 (do not have SIZE=2 or more - omit it if not needed);

How to use the "required" attribute with a "radio" input field

1024 TL;DR: Set the required attribute for at least one input of the radio group. Setting required for all inputs is more clear, but not necessary (unless dynamically generating radio-buttons). To group radio buttons they must all have the same name value. This allows only one to be selected at a time and applies required to the whole group.
